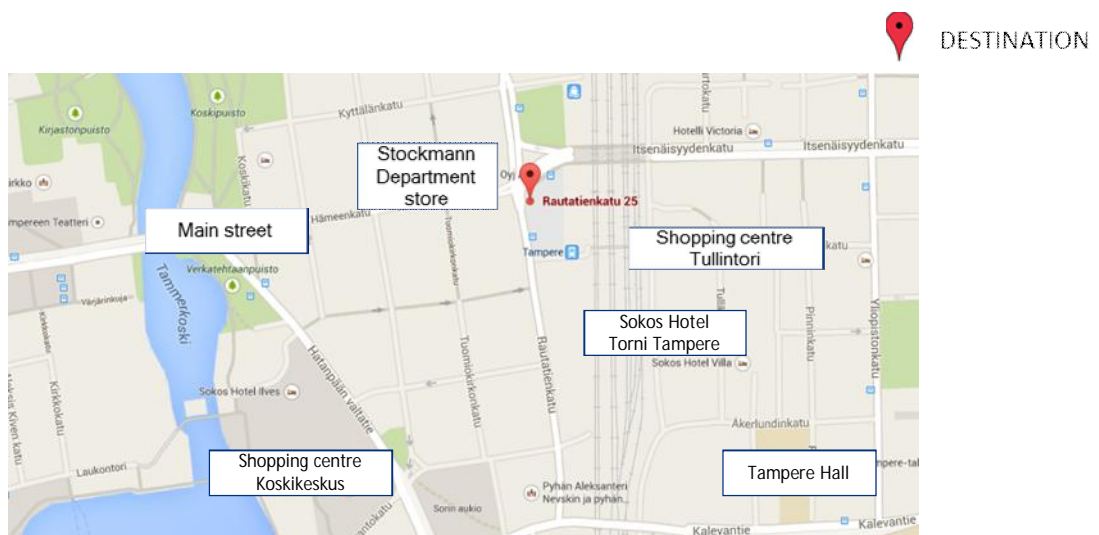


Tampere - Travel and Service Centre is an intersection for traffic and the most significant future public building destination in Tampere

- The Travel and Service Centre will function as the crossing point for the train, bus and tram traffic of the Tampere Region. An international design contest for the development of the travel and service centre was organised in 2014, and the winner was a Danish-Finnish team with their design called ReConnecting Tampere.
- The design contest was a competition on ideas, and none of the proposals as such is suitable as the basis for further design, but the development of the area will be taken forwards based on the guidelines of the winning proposal.
- The next step will be to draw a general plan for the area in cooperation with the citizens.

- The travel and service centre district is the most significant future public building destination in Tampere.
- The area is dimensionally large: the area stretches from Sorinsilta bridge in the south to Erkkilänsilta bridge in the north, and there will be altogether 100,000 – 120,000 m² of new construction in the area, including the functions of the new travel and service centre.
- It is possible to establish a concentration of employments, services and residency in the area, which will form a high-level entirety, both from the cityscape's and the urban structure's point of view.
- The area of the travel and service centre will offer a variety of development possibilities also for private real estate developers.
